Donald later moved to Washington, D.C., became a roofer and served faithfully in the roofing profession for nearly thirty-five years. He was a member of Roofers Local 30. Donald often told stories about the buildings in the DMV he worked on, particularly the federal buildings. His favorite story to tell, was the one about when he worked on the roof of the White House, and how every time the president's helicopter came in for landing, the Secret Service would have him and the other contractors working on the White House come down off the roof and lay on the ground until the president was safely inside.

In retirement, Donald enjoyed watching television, especially sports. His favorite sport of all was wrestling. He also liked old westerns, game shows and on Saturday evenings, he'd faithfully watch the Breeze Country and Grown Folks Dancing programs.

Occasionally, Donald received phone calls from colleagues, friends and family that interrupted his television shows. He answered the phone regardless, especially when his cousin Annabelle called him. Donald enjoyed getting the latest "scoop" from her.

Left to cherish fond memories of Donald are his children Charles Randall and Chandra Jones (Douglas); aunt Annie-Mae Traverse and a host of cousins, extended family and friends.
