In 1966 she met the love of her life, her husband, Mr. Jimmie Lee Mims.

Doreatha loved people especially children. Her signature phrase when ending a conversation with someone was "God loves you, and I love you too." It was common place for her to feed, comfort, and in some cases help raise others children with no qualms and asking for nothing in return. One thing that gave her great pleasure was spending time with family and friends enjoying each others company or talking on the phone. Having a good time with good food and good people was a thing that she truly enjoyed. And as many knew about Doreatha, she did not consider any meal complete without dessert for Dodie had an unquenchable sweet tooth. Butter Pecan ice cream, cookies, and mini candy bars were always present around her kitchen.

Doreatha accepted Christ in her life at an early age and her faith in the Lord was always a source of strength and comfort. In her younger years she was member of Mt. Bethel Baptist church until 1977 when she and her husband joined Bible Way Church where she has been a faithful member ever since. She was member of the Faithful Fellowship Club and then later the Widow's Support Group. It pained her greatly that due to the poor health of her husband Jimmie and then later her own that she could not attend Sunday service regularly but, she always knew that her Bible Way family kept her in prayer and spirit just as she kept them in hers.
