Azzie Lee Jones was born on May 28, 1935 to Lillian Jones, in Sparta Georgia. The oldest of four children, Azzie spent her time with her grandmother and cousins while going to school. In her teen years, she relocated to Petersburg ,Virginia, to help her mother with her three brothers ,while her stepfather served in Korea. She attended and graduated from Peabody High School, and later attended Virginia State College. In the 1960's, she started working as a waitress and hostess in the Officers Club at Fort Lee, Virginia. In 1964, she gave birth to her only child ,Gary. In 1969 she relocated to Washington ,DC, and worked as a waitress at the Walter Reed Officers Club. In 1974, she took the civil service test ,and started her Federal career with the General Accounting Office, then later the General Services Administration, where she worked until she retired in 2006. In 2005, at age 69 ,she received her Bachelors Degree from the University of the District of Columbia, a lifelong goal of hers. Azzie, being a devout Christian, joined First Baptist Church in 1973. While there ,she served as an usher, then later ,President of the Usher Board. She also served as a Sunday school teacher working, with the younger children at church. Azzie was preceded in death by her mother, Lillian Lewis, her brothers

William Jr., and Robert Lewis. She is survived by her brother, Sonny, and her son, Gary D. Jones, and all of her relatives and friends. Azzie's long life made an impact on everyone she met. She will be missed
