Christine J. Johnson lovingly known to her family as “Aunt Christine” was the youngest daughter of Carl Lee Locus and Ada Lee Carter born in Wilson County, NC. Aunt Christine transitioned to her heavenly home on Thursday, July 24, 2025. In addition to her parents, Christine was preceded in death by all her brothers and sisters: Paul, Nancy, Alice, Carl Jr., Florence, Helen, Juanita, and Grady.

Christine retired from the American Political Science Association for 30+ years in the membership department. After a short break, she went to work for Heldreff Publications for 10 years as a receptionist. Aunt Christine attended the Exodus Missionary Baptist Church, where she served as a trustee and deaconess for more than 30 years. Aunt Christine loved traveling abroad with her sister, Juanita (Aunt Neat) visiting Israel, Egypt, Germany, and Russia to name a few.

Aunt Christine had no biological children of her own. She met and married Leon Johnson, a widower with four children and seven

grandchildren that she nurtured and cared for as her own. After Leon's sudden death in 1995, Aunt Christine held together the family to the best of her ability. When she started to decline physically and mentally in 2002, Aunt Christine moved in with her niece, Sheryl, where she lived until her demise. When Aunt Neat's health began to fade, Aunt Christine would pack her bags and go to New York and spend weeks with Aunt Neat. Aunt Christine's physical and mental health rapidly declined after the passing of Aunt Neat, and she began transitioning to the early stages of dementia.

Aunt Christine loved her family and her best friend for life, Bertha Davis. Aunt Christine leaves to cherish her memory, her devoted niece and nephew, Sheryl and Steve (Theresa), step-daughters, Wanda and Julia Johnson, step-grandson, Daenard Johnson that she raised from a baby until the age of 16, 5 grandchildren and 7 great grandchildren, and a host of loving nieces, nephews and friends.
