Doreen Mary Mack was born on October 27, 1937 to the late Norah and Herbert Webster in Huntingdon, England. She was the youngest of two children. Doreen completed her education in the United Kingdom School System.

After graduating High School, she worked several odd jobs before becoming a waitress at the NCO Club on the Royal Air Force in Kimbolton, England. It was there she met the love of her life, Andrew James Mack.

The two were united in marriage and of their union they had five children. This began their worldwide journey.

During their journey, the Mack Family resided in France, Maine, Arizona, California, Washington, D.C., and finally Glenarden, Maryland.

In 1982, Doreen started a career in the Childcare industry. She loved her job so much and rarely missed a day. During this time, she had the pleasure of touching the lives of several children that still remember her to this day. Many generations of children were sent to be with her because of her kind and

loving nature.

Doreen was a dedicated wife and mother to her family and she loved them very much. She enjoyed taking her children on outings and taking summer trips to Kings Dominion as a family tradition.

During her time in Washington, D.C., she loved to visit the Howard Theatre and see acts such as James Brown. She also enjoyed card parties, Scrabble, and an occasional trip to Charlestown races and slots to play the 25 cent machines. She also loved the color green and the Scorpio Zodiac sign.

Doreen also enjoyed sipping coffee and tea, as well as performing word search puzzles to “keep her brain active”. She loved to tell jokes and had a quick wit about her.

She loved to tell you that she was old school and hated modern technology. She never used remote controls or microwaves but the Caller ID was the best invention ever made.

She had a strong work ethic and was very dedicated to her career until she retired from the Haynes Academy in 2018 when her health began to fail.

On the evening of November 26, 2020, Doreen suffered a fall that led her to Prince George’s Hospital in Landover, Maryland. It was there that her health declined, requiring assistance from Hospice Care.

At that time her children decided to bring her home for comfort care. On December 17th at 1:27 p.m., she quietly took her last breath while surrounded by family.
