Geraldine Clara Thomas (lovingly known as Gerry or Ms. Gerry) transitioned peacefully to her final resting place at her home in Washington, DC on the morning of June 29, 2023.

Gerry was born on November 4, 1934, in Scarborough, Tobago to parents, Elton Thomas and Christina Hills. She is the eldest of 8 siblings: Lawrence (D), Dalton (D), Kathleen, Lenora, Charles, Rubena, and Reggie (James). Gerry graduated from Bishops High School in Tobago and went on to further her studies at nursing school in Trinidad. She began her nursing career at Port-of-Spain General Hospital. Her marriage to Sydney Thomas (D) on December 26, 1960, yielded two daughters, Hazel-Ann & Denise Alison (D).

After migrating to the United States, Gerry and her family lived in Springfield, IL, Buffalo, NY, Los Angeles, CA, and most recently, Washington DC. Gerry retired from Georgetown University Hospital in 1999 after 25 years of service. Prior to that she worked at Centinela Valley Hospital in Los Angeles, CA.

Gerry loved traveling and dancing! She was known for cooking her delectable Trinidadian dishes, such as her stew duck and pelau; her “7-UP cake” was a staple at all family and work get-togethers! Her organizational skills and ability to “run the show” was legendary!

Her primary care doctor and nephrologist still talk about how much Gerry helped them and each incoming class of wide-eyed, nervous residents at Georgetown Hospital.

Apart from her parents, Gerry was preceded in death by her husband Sydney, her daughter Denise, her brothers, Lawrence, and Dalton; her aunts Ida, Elizabeth, and Ivy; cousin Eurina and nephews, Kurt Jr and Kurt III. Gerry’s memory will be mourned by daughter, Hazel, cherished grandson Jean-Marc Denis, surviving siblings, Kathy, Lenora, Charles, Ruby and Reggie, and a host of nieces and nephews that include (but are not limited to) Donald, Aethnea, Carla, Claude, Karen, Marlon, Jalisa to name a few.
