Mrs. Maria Daye Johnson McNair passed away peacefully at her home on December 10, 2018. She was born February 26 in the 1930's in Darlington, NC. As a child she, was educated in Halifax County Public Schools and graduated from Chancellor High School. After high school she continued her education at Virginia and Norfolk State Universities majoring in Elementary Education. She was married to Samuel McNair on April 6, 1968. She had 3 children Franchestee Barner, Fitzgerald McNair and Verita Powers.

Maria was very talented with hat designing, sewing to include drapery and upholstery, floral design and created many custom orders for friends and family. She was known as an expert in fabric and precision measurements. Maria was passionate about nutrition, exercise and natural medicine and spent 2 weeks at Wildwood Lifestyle Center in Wildwood, GA in 2017 healing and completing their curriculum. Before she went to heaven Maria was working on a book of her personal natural healing recipes that she shared with others and saw great results. This book is to be published in 2019.

As a Federal civilian employee, she loved her job-serving soldiers in the "Old Guard" as a Master Tailor and retired from Department of Defense after 28 years. Maria formed lifelong friendships with coworkers that she has maintained throughout her retirement years. In retirement she accomplished one of her many dreams of becoming an author. She wrote, "The Autobiography of Maria Daye Johnson McNair Life and Legacy", published in 2016 and can be viewed at the lulu.com web site. Additionally, Maria enjoyed

investing in real estate buying and refurnishing houses. This was her ministry of helping the poor and the needy and she often would let people stay there without any charge.

Maria was an active community volunteer and church member. She was a faithful member of First Baptist Church of Marshall Heights, DC and served as a Missionary and Vocal Choir Member. She also was a member of the First Mount Zion Baptist church in Dumfries, VA where she attended Sunday school and participated in the senior's ministry on a regular basis. Maria was a faithful tither actually paying tithes to both of these churches.

She was a great encourager and received advanced training in CPR and Suicide Prevention. After retirement she continued with her computer training at Prince George's Community College and received many certificates in desktop publishing. Maria was an active member of the Prince William county Senior Center and enjoyed exercising and meeting new friends.

Maria is survived by her beloved husband of 50 years Samuel McNair and children: Franchestee Barner (Honey) of Stafford, VA; Fitzgerald McNair (Fleurette) of San Diego, CA; Verita Powers (Cedric) of Springfield, VA and five grand children: Haven Barner, Cassidy Powers, Gabriella Barner, Jonathan Powers, Faith McNair and a host of nieces, nephews and cousins. She loved God and served him in her everyday life. As a wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, friend, and neighbor she served everyone.
