Obituary

Paul was born July 22, 1975, in Washington, DC, to Langdon Charles Griffin and Judith Ann Griffin. He died March 20, 2024, in Greensboro, North Carolina, with his family (including the "bikers") by his side. He was married to Vernecia Griffin (1999-2015); there were three children from this union: Maya Christine Griffin, Paul Christopher Griffin Jr., and Sydney Camille Griffin.

Paul attended DeMatha Catholic High School in Hyattsville, Maryland, from 1989-1993. Paul graduated and attended Morgan State University in Baltimore, Md., from 1993 -1996, where he pledged and became a member of Phi Omicron Psi Fraternity Inc. in the summer of 1995.

In 1997, Paul signed up with the Local 486 plumbers and steamfitters' union. Paul graduated from an apprenticeship in 2002 as a journeyman plumber. He then went on to work for Metro in Washington, D.C., as a plumber. Paul left

Metro and passed the state test to become a Master plumber. He then started his own business, Griffin Plumbing and Heating.

In 1999, Paul was initiated and conferred his 1st and 2nd degrees, then raised to his 3rd degree to become a Prince Hall Master Freemason under Mt. Moriah Lodge #56 in Baltimore, Md.

One of Paul's greatest loves was "biking," riding with his "family" of bikers across the country. He was known among his biker family as Uncle Paulie. He was a member of the Thunderguard Motorcycle Club.

He lived in Baltimore, Maryland, for much of his adult life, although he recently moved to Axton, Virginia, with his fiancée, Tennell Washington (Goldie).

Paul is predeceased by his mother, father, and sisters, Kimberly Griffin and Terrie Jacobs. He leaves behind three children: Maya, Paul Jr., and Sydney; his sister Sherri Killins Stewart; and his brother-in-law Odell Stewart Jr. His nieces are Monique Renee Stefanou (Charles), Seymone Takia Kreiser (Ryan), Corin Maya Killins, Lynnea Nicole Brown (Richard), and his nephew William Ewell III. He also leaves great nieces and nephews Nicole Stefanou, Renee Brown, Maxx, Leah, and Lauren Thomas. Paul leaves two Loving aunts, Joan Bundy, and Junita Perry. Paul leaves to mourn his loss a host of cousins, including his close cousin Markisha Davis, and a host of friends,

including Malik Gervon Page Sr, Eric "Black" Brown, Kevin "Bigg Kev, KDogg" Tolliver, Brian "Dickey" Dickey Sr. and Kevin Melton Sr., who loved Paul and each other like brothers.
