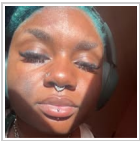

*when I received notification from Traci, I hastily emailed the following: Traci and Theresa death notice April 13, 2021*

*Dearest Traci, in our darkest hours it seems that there always comes a blessed light to remind us of the goodness of God that we are here to lighten the burdens of one another. Your call today though it bore a sad message was a gifted relief to know that my long-term friend and buddy Teresa is safe in the arms of the beloved master. Though my eyes shared the tears of sadness that I am no longer able to seek help and guidance from my friend; there is a sense of gladness for the hours that we have spent, and the good that we have done in the true meaning of service. My prayer is that you will share the gladness and the reward that you have done the best that you could in the service and care of your mother and friend. Though we have lost the messenger we have not lost the message of service and reward of being a good and faithful servant. I don't know what Maxine and I are going to write for others to see, but to you Donna and Marceline I only quote "Well done, good and faithful servants...." Love Lawrence*

*For the past 72 hours I have debated was this email to Tracy and a phone call to Marcelino enough to archives the life of compassionate service and rewards of Teresa. As I recall, in November 1957, on a cold Saturday afternoon, I took my mother to Hadley Memorial Hospital in Southeast Washington DC. It was at Hadley's that I struggled with the death of my mother, Charlotte Luella Washington, who brought into my life Audrey Maxine Wise and Teresa Johnson plus her sister Marceline Butler. Without Teresa I would have not captured and married the love of my life Audrey Maxine Washington (Maxine). Without Teresa we would not have stood with our first-born Audrey Matrice Washington (Matrice),*

*in Dupont Park SDA church as pastor Reginald Robinson gave guardianship to Teresa and blessed our relationships. So it was that relationship continued in periodic face-to-face meetings as we traversed through the years. Our final meeting, October 2019, Maxine and I celebrated our 63rd anniversary and the purchase of a new home in San Antonio Texas. In all of our face-to-face contacts I have terminated as though we would never share this earthly relation again. I would simply be commemorating the words of the Scripture, "May the Lord watch between me and the while we are absent one from another". Genesis 31:49 NASB. SO LET BE.*
