Obituary

Thomas Lee Hawkins Jr. was born to Nina Elizabeth Hurt-Hawkins and the late Thomas Lee Hawkins Sr. on August 9, 1962, in Richmond, Virginia.

Thomas affectionately known as “Tommy,” transitioned on Sunday, June 1, 2025, and now abides in the presence of the Lord. Tommy was baptized in Jesus’ name and filled with the Holy Ghost early in life. His faith became the foundation upon which he built his values, shaped his actions, and extended love and grace to others.

As the middle child of three siblings, Tommy carried from an early age a quiet strength, deep compassion, and an unwavering devotion to family. Tommy later continued his engineering craft where he earned a career at Inova Alexandria Hospital, where he was known for his reliability, quiet strength and steady presence by both colleagues and patients.

Tommy met and married Selma Hawkins. From their union, they were blessed with two children; Christopher Hawkins and Kiana Hawkins.

He later met Lisa Jackson-Hall and from their union they were blessed with Ryan Jackson. They remained great friends until his death.

Tommy was far more than a skilled tradesman—he was a mentor, a storyteller and a gentle soul. He possessed a rare gift for making people feel seen, heard and valued. His love for animals, especially dogs, revealed yet another layer of his kind heart. Tommy played an instrumental role in the dog-breeding community, inspiring and teaching others, even those once fearful to understand and appreciate these loyal companions.

Tommy's laughter filled every room he entered. His words of encouragement carried wisdom, his support was consistent, and his presence is unforgettable. To know him was to experience warmth, patience, and a genuine spirit.

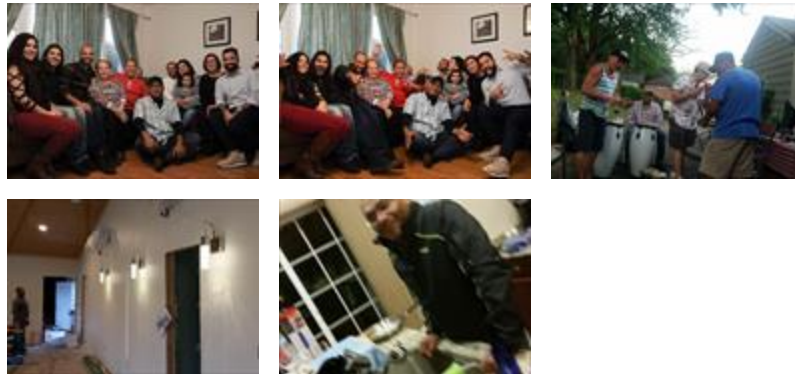
